Helpful Hints- Compliments of The Paper Station

1. Have your invitations weighed at the post office prior to mailing with all items inserted.
2. Do **NOT** stamp the respond envelopes that are being mailed to guests outside of the USA.
3. Do **NOT** abbreviate the addresses; spell out city, state name, road, avenue, etc.
4. Have your invitations hand postmarked at the post office; this will keep your envelopes neat looking.
5. Mail your invitations out 8 weeks prior to your wedding day.
